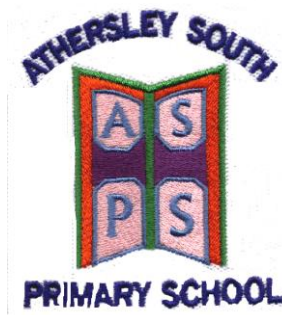

Dear Parents

We have pleasure in sharing the new class arrangements with you. Your child will be in xxx (*this will have been edited for your child*) and their class teacher will be xxx. Your child will move to their new class next Monday 16<sup>th</sup> July. From this date you should drop off and collect your child at their new entrance/exit. Arrangements for current F2 children vary slightly as on Monday they will enter and exit through their normal door over in the EYFS unit.

During transition our Y6 children will be taught by Miss C. Smith. The present Y6 children will be based in the Spanish room and should enter through the Y4 door where Miss C. Smith has been all year.
